- 3. Strong analytical and problem-solving skills with the ability to diagnose and resolve complex technical issues.

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- 4. Demonstrated ability to successfully manage several competing project priorities simultaneously.
- 5. Demonstrated customer-focused approach when formulating project solutions.
- 6. Excellent verbal and written communication skills, with the ability to articulate technical information clearly to both technical and non-technical stakeholders.
- 7. Meticulous attention to detail and a commitment to maintaining high standards of operational excellence.
- 8. Self-motivated and proactive in identifying potential issues and implementing preventative measures in consultation with the Developer Team Lead.
