Role Overview

The role of Technical Services staff in CSIRO is to provide support for scientific research in a diverse range of laboratory and field situations across a range of different research projects. This support consists of the application of accepted technical practices and the development of new practices. The work is usually carried out as a member of a centralised service.

As the SAP Senior Basis Administrator you will be responsible for the installation, upgrade, and maintenance of SAP systems, databases and Operating Systems.

Additional configuring, monitoring, tuning, and troubleshooting the SAP technical environment, scheduling and executing the SAP transport system, design of interfaces between SAP and external systems, optimize and analyse performance issues, review and design architectures of the landscape.

As part of the SAP Solutions Team in IM&T you will provide specialist SAP knowledge and have a positive impact in CSIRO by;

- Working collaboratively with key Finance, People stakeholders and IM&T staff to establish the design and development of systems to support projects within the roadmap.
- Bringing together multiple functions across the organisation to create a streamlined and harmonious systems experience for our people.
- Harnessing insights and data from across CSIRO to inform the development of system solutions that support leading practices and processes.

Selection Criteria

Essential

1. Minimum 15 years experience working as an SAP Basis Administrator with demonstrated experience of system architecture, configuration and operations.

- 2. Demonstrated experience in stopping/starting of SAP instances/Databases and Operating Systems in both a windows and linux environment.
- 3. Demonstrated experience in management of Transport Management System including scheduling and executing transport requests in a multi-tier environment.
- 4. Demonstrated experience of backup administration and disaster recovery including Database and Operating Systems
- 5. Demonstrated experience of system integration administration including monitoring, maintenance and updating integrations with internal and cloud applications.
- 6. Demonstrated experience of system administration including SAP Kernal upgrades, SAP OSS note implementation, applying SAP Add-ons/Support packs, Operating System monitoring/patching/upgrades, Database monitoring/patching/upgrades, Operating System space/disk management.
- 7. Demonstrated experience in SAP Batch job creation/configuration/maintenance and management.
- 8. Demonstrated experience and knowledge in SAP security including patching reviews and management.
- 9. Demonstrated experience performing SAP system data refreshes in a multi-tiered environment.
- 10. Demonstrated experience in designing future state architecture for on-premise and cloud solutions including S/4HANA, SuccessFactors and Business Technology Platform.

Desirable

1. Demonstrated experience in team leadership and mentoring activities

Required Competencies

Evaluates, interprets and integrates complex bodies of information and draws logical conclusions, synthesises proposals and defends options with reasoned arguments.
- Independence: Assesses the risk and opportunity of identified strategies, options and actions.
 Overcomes problems and setbacks in achieving goals. Invariably includes consideration of value-added future impact on bottom line when determining the optimal and efficient use of resources.

• **Adaptability:** Demonstrates flexibility in thinking and adapts to and manages the increasing rate of organisational change by adjusting strategies, goals and priorities.
