Role Overview

The role of Technical Services staff in CSIRO is to provide support for scientific research in a diverse range of laboratory and field situations across a range of different research projects. This support consists of the application of accepted technical practices and the development of new practices. The work is usually carried out as a member of a centralised service.

As the SAP Senior Technical Consultant, you will be responsible for the Strategic direction, Security, and technical design of SAP systems.

You will be responsible for configuring / monitoring / tuning and troubleshooting the SAP technical environment.

You will be responsible for administration and monitoring of the Employee Self Service portal including integrations with backend systems such as SAP ECC, SAP SRM, SAP BW/4HANA, SAP Business Objects and SAP Analytics Cloud.

You will be responsible for optimising and analysing Security roles and user administration in SAP Netweaver Portal, SAP ECC, SAP SRM and SAP BW/4HANA.

You will be responsible for general SAP solution architecture including reviewing and designing future state architecture of the landscape.

As part of the SAP Solutions Team in IM&T you will provide specialist SAP knowledge and have a positive impact in CSIRO by;

- Working collaboratively with key Finance, People stakeholders and IM&T staff to establish the design and development of systems to support projects within the roadmap.
- Bringing together multiple functions across the organisation to create a streamlined and harmonious systems experience for our people.

 - Design and administration of Single Sign On solutions in on-premise and cloud identity/service providers using SAML, Kerberos and OAuth protocols.
 - Support security aspects of Robotic Process Automation.
 - o SAP security auditing expertise.
 - Knowledge of Essential 8 and general cyber security aspects of SAP on-premise and cloud landscapes.

Required Competencies

- **Independence:** Assesses the risk and opportunity of identified strategies, options and actions. Overcomes problems and setbacks in achieving goals. Invariably includes consideration of value-added future impact on bottom line when determining the optimal and efficient use of resources.
- Adaptability: Demonstrates flexibility in thinking and adapts to and manages the increasing rate of organisational change by adjusting strategies, goals and priorities.
